2014-2015 Accomplishments**

**Describe personal and school/department accomplishments during the 2014– 2015 school-year that were not identified on your Continuous School/Department Improvement Status Report or the Professional Goals Status Report.**

1. Designated an “A” School by the State of Indiana for 2014-2015 (Fifth “A” in a row)
2. Named, as one of only three schools in Indiana, as a “Quality Matters” school. The award is based on five areas of school quality – strong leadership, high expectations, a safe environment, emphasis on skill mastery, and frequent assessments of student progress.
3. Named a National Blue Ribbon School - 2011
4. Received 4 Star School Status for the eighth time from the State of Indiana
5. Maintained very high ranking in the State on the ISTEP+ Honor Roll (Total Passing Rate 90% or higher)
6. Designated the State of Indiana Spell Bowl Champions
7. Under No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Eisenhower School consistently earned Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) for the past thirteen years.
8. Our CPCSC ECD program successfully serviced a record number of preschool students. Much work has been done and will continue to make our pre-school program a model for others to emulate both locally and statewide. The preschool program is preparing to move to the new Crown Point Early Learning Center for the 2015-16 school year.
9. IREAD3 passing rate (100%) for all third graders at Eisenhower was the highest in the corporation.
10. A Preschool Advisory Group, including directors of our area preschools, completed its third year of collaboration in our effort to ensure better transitions to kindergarten for both general education and exceptional learner students. A kindergarten orientation video was created to visually enable a successful transition to kindergarten for both students and parents.
