Crown Point Parents,

We are nearing the end of our fourth week of school and I want to thank our students, parents, teachers, administrators, and staff members for a great start to the school year. There is no question we have faced challenges over the last several weeks and we will continue to see challenges in the coming weeks and months. I appreciate our students and the way they have handled changes to the school day. They have adjusted to wearing masks, changes in lunchroom procedures, transportation guidelines, and classroom expectations in a way that should make all of us proud.

When we released our Continuous Learning Plan for the 20-21 school year, we indicated we would continue to monitor where we as a community, county, and state were and we would respond accordingly. We have been reviewing the data that is provided to us as well as the data we have been able to collect from within Crown Point Community School Corporation. All of these data points indicate that we are moving in the right direction.

As we consider the possibility of changing the status of our back to school plan, there are a few things we will have to adjust if we move to the status of Green. We will not be able to meet the social distancing guideline of six feet between individuals and based on Governor Holcomb's executive order, we will have to require our students to wear a face mask most, if not all, of the time they are in our school buildings. This is an important distinction because the survey results we received before the start of the school year indicated that 40% of our parents would not send their students to school if they had to wear a mask all day. I suspect that percent may have changed over the last several weeks, but we need to know. We also need to know if there will be a change in the number of parents who will want to move their students from in person learning to the distance learning model.

Early next week parents will be asked to complete a short survey regarding information we will need as we consider our future plans for this school year. I ask that you complete that survey in a timely manner so we can make an informed decision.
